Sustainability Balanced Scorecard





The <u>Organizational Readiness for Sustainability Working Group</u> is exploring the potential to develop a Sustainability Balanced Scorecard for TAHSN with the aim to:

- Provide common sustainability objectives and indicators
- o Support TAHSN organizations in assessing and celebrating their own annual improvement
- Complement and support existing TAHSN goals and metrics

Based on a review of the literature, a strategic approach is to integrate sustainability into existing balanced scorecard frameworks. As such, the Working Group is considering developing a Sustainability Balanced Scorecard to complement existing TAHSN Balanced Scorecards, which would be comprised of:

- **Dimensions:** Perspectives of organizational performance in alignment with common dimensions in TAHSN Balanced Scorecards where sustainability objectives could be integrated.
- **Sustainability Objectives:** Select sustainability objectives, informed by existing TAHSN sustainability goals, availability of support or resources for implementation, and consultation.
- o Indicators: Performance measures for each sustainability objective, in line with existing monitoring.
